#### DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are prohibited from the trial grounds.

Please consult the AKC's Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es) and height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated. All exhibitors can obtain a copy of the AKC's Regulations for Agility Trials. The Regulations may be downloaded for free from the American Kennel Club website at <a href="http://www.AKC.ORG/rules/">http://www.AKC.ORG/rules/</a> (then look under the "Sports" heading).

#### **ENTRIES**

Illegible or incomplete entries will be returned. All entries must be on official AKC entry forms or photocopies and must include the agreement and rules. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Owners are responsible for all errors on entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Type or print carefully to prevent error.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

A maximum of ten (10) entries are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. Each dog is considered one (1) entry regardless of the number of classes entered. Envelopes with more than ten (10) entries will be returned to the sender.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add up to a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

#### **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRY**

Acknowledgment of entry acceptance will be emailed upon processing to those listing a legible email address on their entry form. If you would like written confirmation of the status of your entry prior to the issuance of the judging schedule upon closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope along with your entry.

#### **WAIT LIST**

Per Chapter 1, Section 16 Item 1 of the "Regulations for Agility Trials", entries received prior to the Closing Date but in excess of the trial entry limits shall be placed on a Wait List. The Wait List shall be used to fill openings created by entries withdrawing up to <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>July 20, 2021 at 5 PM</u>. The Wait List shall be limited to 50 entries each day. A full refund will be reimbursed to any entrant whose withdrawn entry can be replaced by a wait-listed entry.

#### **REFUNDS**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the the Club. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

**Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees paid less a \$5 processing fee per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason provided the Club is able to fill the slots reserved for that dog from the Waiting List and upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

#### MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog measured by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Note: At least one Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) will be present onsite each day. On some days we may have two VMOs available. Check with the Trial Chair for the identity of the VMO(s) present each day.

#### **Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the <u>Entry Form</u>, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

#### **MOVE UPS**

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title. The request should be made in writing by mail or e-mail to the Trial Secretary, no later than 5 p.m., Monday, July 25, 2022. Dogs moved up will be at the end of the running order. MOVEUPS during the weekend of the show (for Friday, Saturday or Sunday Trials) will be allowed provided a written Move-Up request is submitted to the Trial Secretary by 6:00 PM the previous day.

#### **OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS**

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a artificial grass surface. Ring size will be 100' x 90'. Electronic timing will be used. The equipment for this event is being provided by **MAX 200** and will be available for sale at the end of the event. If you are interested in a specific item, it is requested that you reserve it ahead of time. For more information, you may call MAX 200 at 800-446-2920 or e-mail them at sales@max200.com

#### COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. The time and length of the walk-through will be the Judge's discretion.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training of the dog.

# RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

A "New Title" rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH rosette and decorated MACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH. A PACH rosette and decorated PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their PACH.

#### BEREERE F.A.S.T. CLASS BEREERE

Saturday's **FAST** Class is a titling class where each dog/handler team earns points for successful completion of different obstacle <u>and</u> successfully completing a "SEND" sequence of 2 or 3 obstacles where the handler must stay behind a "SEND" line. This class will be run according to the AKC's revised guidelines for FAST:

- A single basic course will be used for all 3 levels with variations for the SEND portion appropriate for the Level of the dog.
- All 3 Levels (Excellent/Master, Open and Novice and their Preferred groups) will be briefed together, walk together and then all levels will be run at the same time by height.
- All levels will use 12 weave poles

#### TIME 2 BEAT CLASS BEBER BEAT CLASS

The TIME 2 BEAT class is a titling class is open to <u>all</u> dogs running in AKC Agility Trials. The Class has no "levels" (Novice, Open, Excellent or Master). Instead all dogs run the same course and compete equally against other dogs in their same height category. Preferred dogs run at their preferred height. The class is a fast-paced class with jumps, tunnels, 12 weave poles and either an A-Frame, a Seesaw/Teeter or both (Every run will require that 2 Contact obstacles be successfully completed). There is no Table or Dogwalk. Run-Outs/Refusals are not judged though Wrong Courses and Dropped Bars are judged and are non-qualifying faults.

#### BEREITE PREMIER CLASS BEREITER

The PREMIER classes (Premier Standard and Premier Jumpers with Weaves) are titling classes open to <u>all</u> dogs running in AKC Agility Trials. The class typically requires a higher level of handling skill and mobility of the dog/handler team. The Class has no "levels" (Novice, Open, Excellent or Master). Instead all dogs run the same course and compete equally against other dogs in their same height category. Preferred dogs run at their preferred height. The class is a fast-paced class with jumps, tunnels, 12 weave poles and the A-Frame, Seesaw/Teeter and Dogwalk. There is no Table.

#### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

#### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. BOTC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the BOTC or any official thereof.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The State of Vermont requires a rabies vaccination every three years.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

#### **CATALOGS**

Advance catalog sales may be ordered and prepaid with your entry form for a \$5 charge. A limited number of catalogs will be available for sale

#### **RINGSIDE**

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class by the judge of record or a VMO or AKC Field Rep if one is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required, at the trial site for a cost of \$5. Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge.

#### **COVID PROTOCOLS**

Covid continues to be with us and it's prevalence and patterns continue to vary. Vaccination rates continue to rise but Covid cases are also still climbing. BOTC will have Covid protocols in place for the trial. See the Covid Protocols page at at the end of this Premium.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

**Indoor Crating space** will be available. All dogs crated within the building must be located with designated crating area. Please respect the lines denoting the crating area and keep exits open. The trial site requires a tarp to be placed on the floor underneath your crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, BOTC and The Field House will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

All Dogs Must Be on Leash both inside and outside the building except when crated, using the warm-up jump or competing in the ring.

#### **VENDORS**

- There will be a variety of vendors at the trial. Vendors will honor volunteer worker tickets.

#### **PARKING**

- The Site Has Parking in reasonable proximity to the building.

#### **OUTDOOR WALKING AREAS FOR DOGS**

- There is ample outdoor space for walking dogs both on the Trial Site and on the Public Sidewalks leading away from the Trial Site.
- Please do not walk dogs on the actual playing field surfaces of the soccer fields on the Trial Site. Dogs may be walked around the outside of these fields.

- No food/eating on the artificial turf. There is a mezzanine with tables and chairs overlooking the trial ring and there is an indoor area on the ground level with tables and chairs.
- No alcohol may be brought into the building.

# BURLINGTON OBEDIENCE TRAINING CLUB's July 2022 Agility Trials

Thursday, July 28, 2022 thru Sunday, July 31, 2022 Shelburne Field House 166 Athletic Drive Shelburne, Vermont

The Burlington Obedience Training Club is pleased to be able to hold its annual July agility trials this year after having had to cancel all of our 2020 Agility Trials and our April 2021 Trials due to the Covid-19 pandemic. With increasing rates of vaccinations and dropping Covid case rates, the State of Vermont has steadily relaxed its Covid rules and safety protocols. That relaxation is the reason BOTC will be able to offer its July Agility Trials.

Current Vermont Conditions (per the Vermont Department of Health)

COVID-19 is currently spreading at higher levels in Vermont. During these times, it is important to reassess your personal risk and strongly consider when to take prevention steps, such as wearing a high-quality mask in indoor public spaces. If you have any symptoms, get tested. If you test positive and are at higher risk, contact your health care provider right away to get treatment.

What does this mean for BOTC?

In broad terms, we think it means that we'll be able to operate our trials in a manner quite similar to our normal practices. However, we also believe that we will need to respect the lessons Vermonters have learned from the pandemic and balance our enthusiasm for the event with an appropriate degree of caution out of respect for the Covid-19 virus and concern for our friends and fellow agility enthusiasts.

To that end, following are the guidelines that BOTC will be following in the coming weeks and over the 4-day trial period as the Covid environment continues to evolve toward the "normal" we all used to know and hope to return to.

# BOTC will operate the trial in as "normal" a fashion as we can ..... BUT:

1. We will follow whatever guidelines/mandates/rules that are set by the State of Vermont, the Town of Shelburne, and the Shelburne Field House - our host site,

#### AND

- 2. All attendees at the trial whether competitors, BOTC club members, friends or the public will be required to wear masks when inside the building except when actually running a dog in the competition ring.
  - Note: We believe that the "mandatory mask" protocol will be the most appropriate way to balance the Covid risks with the rewards of being able to see our friends, have fun with our dogs and compete in agility.
- 3. We may have some other Covid-specific practices in place for the trial period but this will be dependent on the Covid situation at that time and any changes in required practices that are adopted by the State of Vermont the Town of Shelburne and the Shelburne Field House. These practices are likely to relate to the small details of the trial day such as distribution of course maps, managing gate sheet check in and distributing Q and placement ribbons.
- 4. Here are a few of the specific practices that have been missing from agility trials this past year we think we'll be able to do:
  - A. <u>Crating</u> We expect to allow indoor crating .....though we may mandate social distancing in the crating areas. We'll mark out the floor to reflect whatever standard is in effect at that time.
  - B. <u>Spectators</u> We expect to be able to allow spectators other handlers and the public to watch the competition from within the building ..... but wearing masks and subject to social distancing rules and guidelines.
  - C. Onsite Food Vendor We don't expect to have a food vendor at the site. But competitors may bring their own food/drink. As usual, such food/drink will not be allowed on the indoor athletic fields.
  - D. <u>Vendors</u> We will be allowing vendors at the trial. Those located within the building will follow the Covid protocols, including wearing masks.
- 5. <u>Traveling to Vermont</u> At the present time Vermont does not have any state travel restrictions for state residents or for people coming to Vermont from other states. There are federal rules that apply in Vermont. These include testing for international travel and wearing masks on public transportation.
